INSTRUCTIONAL

BROAD-BASED LOCAL PARTICIPATION

The Board shall appoint a Graduation Standards Implementation Committee which shall advise the Board on implementation of the state and local graduation requirements, including K-12 curriculum, assessment, student learning opportunities and other related issues. This committee shall consist of the following representation including students, educators, parents, or guardians and community members. Among the members shall be individuals who are able to represent the needs of students throughout the district including those with special needs. Recommendations of this committee will be made to the board by March 1, 1998; and annually thereafter, all necessary policies regarding graduation standards implementation. These policies shall be published to the citizens of the district and shall be reviewed in open meetings during March and April. Policies shall be adopted, revised, and/or renewed by the Board in May of each year.
