Nonprescription medication (Form 408-A)

High student (grades 7-12) may possess and use nonprescription pain relief medication (*ibuprofen or acetaminophen*) in a manner consistent with the labeling, if the school district has received written authorization from the student's parent or guardian permitting the student to self-administer the medication. The parent or guardian must submit written authorization form 408-A for the student to self-administer the medication. The consent form must be renewed each year. The school district may revoke a student's privilege to possess and use nonprescription pain relievers if the school district determines that the student is abusing the privilege. This provision does not apply to the possession or use of any drug or product containing ephedrine or pseudoephedrine as an active ingredient.
